SENATOR CLARK: He has closed. The question is the advancement of 749. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are voting on the advancement of LB 749 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. Go ahead. The Clerk has got some items to read into the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new bill, LB 765A, introduced by Senator Lamb. (Read by title for the first time as found on page 690 of the Journal.)

Your committee on Judiciary whose chairman is Senator Nichol to whom is referred LB 600 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File and 605 General File with amendments, (Signed) Senator Nichol. (See pages 693-694 of the Journal.)

Your committee on Public Health and Welfare whose chairman is Senator Cullan to whom is referred LB 94 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File, 686 General File with amendments, 789 General File with amendments, (Signed) Senator Cullan, Chairman.
