

recall for at least a year. The bill originally said something about 30% of the voters in the last election. That has been changed to 25% and it is the number of voters that voted for the last election for Governor in that particular district or in that particular subdivision, whatever it might be. I think it is a good bill. I am not going to waste your time. It does put it in line exactly with what we have been doing in the cities. There has been some problems with recalls. Some officials have been harassed and one other provision of the bill that I might mention is that before you can start a petition drive and if you didn't get enough signatures you could just kind of let it set until something else came up in the county proceedings and then you could go out and get a few more signatures and after a while you would finally get enough to have an election or a recall.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kahle, the time is up and I need to ask, Senator Keyes, are you going to propose an amendment?

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I have an amendment up there. Now it can be offered here or it can be offered on Select File. If we have run out of time...let's vote on advancing the bill and then I will have to take it up when it comes up on Select File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

SENATOR KAHLE: I move we vote on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to advance 601 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 601 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: Yes, sir. (Read title to LB 957.) The bill was read on January 23 of this year, referred to the Appropriations Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. Senator Warner does have committee amendments pending. Mr. President.
