SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Lewis amendment to LB 615. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Lewis' amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Any other amendments to 615?

CLERK: Yes, sir. We now have the amended committee amendments to adopt. Government Committee by Senator Keyes.
