CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 757 and 758, Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 602 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 654.

CLERK: Final Reading of LB 654.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 654 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 758 and 759, Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 1 nay, 1 excused and not voting, 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 654 passes with the emergency clause attached. That will conclude Final Reading for this morning.
