CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, a Speaker's announcement regarding placement of bills on Special Order.

Senator Haberman and Senator Koch offer explanations of vote.

Your committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance whose Chairman is Senator DeCamp to whom we referred LB 877 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments. (Signed) Senator DeCamp.

This does not mean that the Chair will not encourage you to limit discussion. LB 499 has been past us at least twice during this session and the Chair hopes that we can complete the discussion this morning in regard to that bill. So the first order of business under Select File is LB 499.
