SENATOR DE CAMP: Richard is sued. A judgment is gotten against him and they take Richard's house that Richard owns with his wife. That is how this bill works, I claim. Tell me I am wrong, Chris.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Lamb. Senator Lamb. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, I call for the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay, all those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate ceases. The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler to close on his amendment to LB 306.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Just a couple of remarks, Mr. Speaker. It always continues to amaze me that Senator DeCamp can come along at a late point in a debate and say something that has been said the first day and discuss the first day and it appears to be some kind of a revelation to him. We have said from the very beginning it is personal liability. You sue the surviving joint tenant. The theory on that is that in this particular example he got the benefit of all Senator Marsh's property. Suddenly he owns all that property so what is so bad about having him pay the debt.....especially if it is \$148? The only other remark I would like to make and I have been saying this individually to particular senators but I am committing myself to one additional amendment to this bill in addition to the one that was before you today and I am committing myself to attach that amendment, not to this bill should it make it through Final Reading, but to another bill, LB 981, which is a bill of mine which is on General File. It is a small bill. It is noncontroversial. I am not attaching it to this bill for I think reasons that will strategically, tactical reasons that I think will be obvious to all of you.
