SENATOR DeCAMP: Changing from aye to nay for purposes of reconsideration.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp, changing from no to yes. Senator Kennedy voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Okay.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 18 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and LB 612 is indefinitely postponed. Let's wait and see, just a moment here. The Legislature will be at ease for a moment. While we are waiting for the Speaker to come back, the Chair would like to recognize some visitors from Senator Schmit's, DeCamp's, Kremer's and Chronister's Districts, 23 members of the East Central Nebraska Chapter of Bank Administrators Institute. They are up here in the North balcony. Would they stand and be recognized? Welcome to your Legislature. Stand up, folks. The motion was to raise the Call. The Call is raised. We will take up the next bill, LB 94. Matters to be read in first.

CLERK: Very quickly, Mr. President, LB 790A, title read.

Your committee on Rules whose Chairman is Senator Fowler gives notice of public hearing in Room 1517 for February 25.

Mr. President, LB 94, title read. The bill was read for the first time on January 5 of 1979. It was referred to the Public Health and Welfare Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. On March 14, committee amendments were adopted. On March 15, the bill failed to advance. There were several amendments adopted last year by the body, (inaudible) offered by Senator Wesely, a second amendment offered by Senator Wesely was adopted. Senator Marsh had an amendment that was adopted. Senator Chambers had amendments that were defeated. A motion was made on March 22nd of last year to refer the bill back to the Public Health and Welfare. That motion prevailed. I now have committee amendments pending by Senator Cullan's Public Health and Welfare Committee.
