Will you please stand so we may recognize you. Will all legislators please take their seats. You will notice that the calendar shows thirty days. It means that we are half through. We have to keep moving or we are not even going to come close to taking care of the business for the second thirty days. Will the legislators please take your seats so we can proceed with Final Reading, and all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The first bill is LB 703 on Final Reading. The Clerk will read.

CLERK: (Read 703 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Murphy asks unanimous consent to lay over 703. Senator Goodrich is excused today. Is there any objection? Senator Hoagland. Senator Murphy. Okay, what is the status of the thing? Senator Hoagland, do you withdraw your objection? Okay, there is a unanimous consent request to lay over 703 until tomorrow. Is there any objection? Okay, so ordered. The next bill on Final Reading is LB 723.

CLERK: (Commenced reading LB 723.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Excuse me. All legislators please take your seats on Final Reading. Okay, go ahead.

CLERK: (Read LB 723 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: Senator Merz voting aye. (Read record vote as found on page 836 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 2 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed. Before we proceed to the next bill on Final Reading, underneath the north balcony from Imperial, Nebraska, Senator Haberman's District, it is my privilege to present the Principal of the Grade School, Evancho Dimitri. Will you please stand up? The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 766.
