SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Next bill, LB 507.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 507 does have the E & R amendments pending.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: There we go. I move the E & R amendments to LB 507.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a set of amendments offered by Senator Kremer and I believe they are on page 749, Mr. President. I am going to check on that. They are offered by Senator Kremer. Mr. President, they are on page 749 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman and members, these actually are simple amendments. One is rather substantive and that is it makes very clear that a vote of the people is required when local tax funds are expended. That's all it does. The rest of them are technical amendments. I move the adoption of these amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Kremer amendments to LB 507. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We are voting on the adoption of the Kremer amendment to LB 507. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Kremer's amendment.
