SPEAKER MARVEL: The question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators should be in their seats. Unauthorized personnel should leave the floor. Record your presence. Senator Cope, Senator Johnson, Senator Haberman, Senator Pirsch, Senator Kelly. There are eight excused at the moment. Do you want to start on roll call? Okay, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 849 and 850 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 18 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost. Senator Barrett, would you like to....I'm sorry, go ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, new resolution, LR 203, offered by Senator Venditte. (Read LR 203 as found on page 850 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over, Mr. President.

Your committee on Judiciary whose Chairman is Senator Nichol to whom was referred LB 808 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File.
