

the Warner amendment to LB 959. Have you all voted? It's your second bill on Select File. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Now what is the second amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh moves to amend. Would you like me to read it, Senator? The amendment would read as follows: (Read Maresh amendment as found on page 869 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, this amendment is to help these people that maintain these antique boilers, the steam engines for public display. They have to have them inspected if they are to be displayed...demonstrated, and one person that I know of holds an annual event where he makes an exhibition of these boilers and it would be quite a problem to pay the fee the way the bill is designed presently at \$30 per steam engine and he has six of these. It would be quite a cost where he does not charge admission to the event. I think it would be unfair for this person to have to pay this large fee, so my amendment states that the first boiler would be \$20. I originally was trying to propose a \$10 fee but the boiler inspectors told me that sometimes they have to drive quite a distance to inspect the boiler and so what I am doing is saying \$20 for the first one and then each one after that would be \$6 just like it is presently, and if they are inspected the same time. "The same time" was added on the suggestion of Senator Marsh. She thought that we should specify that they would have to be inspected the same time. So I move that this amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Maresh amendment to LB 959. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted on the Maresh amendment to.... record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Maresh amendment, Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator Warner would now ask to lay the bill over.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion on the Maresh amendment is adopted, and the bill is now laid over as per request from Senator Warner. Okay, are we ready for the next bill, LB 765?
