PRESIDENT: Okay, so noted. All right, Mr. Clerk, is that it? We will proceed then with special order agenda item #5, LB 82 we will start with and, Mr. Clerk, do you want to read that?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 82 was introduced by the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was first read on January 5, 1979. It was referred to the Constitutional, Revision and Recreation Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Reutzel's Constitutional Committee.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Mr. President, members of the body, I would move the adoption of the committee amendments at this time. The amendments are rather extensive and they do become the bill. We did have a rehearing on the new amendments this year just to alleviate any problems people might have with that rewrite so I would move the adoption of the amendments now and then we can explain the bill.

PRESIDENT: All right, we proceed then to explain the... do you have anything further on the amendments?

SENATOR REUTZEL: No, I would just as soon...

PRESIDENT: All right, so the question before the House is the adoption of the committee amendments. Is there any discussion on the committee amendments to LB 82? If not, all in favor of adopting the committee amendments vote aye, opposed nay. Could we all vote on this, one way or another? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on the adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carried. The committee amendments are adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Reutzel.
