SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Clark, do you want to adjourn us until 9:00 o'clock tomorrow morning?

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, I move that we adjourn until 9:00 o'clock, March the 5th, 9:00 a.m.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Before we adjourn for the afternoon, we will assume that the weather will relax so that you can come tomorrow. If there is not an adequate number then we can...we are authorized to simply declare tomorrow not a legislative day. That is me. And I would call your attention that we have, weather permitting, we have three Special Orders. So the motion is that we adjourn until nine tomorrow morning. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. We are, and it is unanimous, we are adjourned.
