CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 615.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move the E & R amendments to LB 615.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 615. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner now moves to amend the bill: Read Warner amendment found on page 1006, Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the Lewis amendment you will recall the other day that was adopted contained language indicating that if a state car was available that it must be utilized and I visited with Senator Lewis and he concurs that it can be removed. If you look at the language that was adopted on the amendment dealing with the state on February 11th, you will see that existing law which is in the bill where the mileage is changed already contains provisions requiring the use of a state vehicle and the conditions that must exist if a state vehicle is not to be used and that means...if a personal vehicle can't be used, and that is only when it is done at the convenience of the individual rather than the convenience of the agency and the two would..are somewhat...well, they are not totally compatible and would cause confusion and I think by removing the language, the protection that Senator Lewis wants is still in the law and I believe it should more appropriately be removed so that there is no issue of, if there is any contradiction, between the two wording and there really isn't but it could be...at best it is a duplication.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Lewis, do you wish to speak to the Warner amendment to 615?

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. President, I put the amendment on to answer the concerns that Senator Warner has, and if his concerns have been resolved by the amendment I put on, I certainly agree to take the amendment I put on for him to
