LB 632, 632A, 651, 705

to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced to E & R for review as amended. The next bill is LB 705.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have an A bill on 632.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I'm sorry. Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 632A introduced by the Ag and Environment Committee. (Read title.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Lamb, do you want to move the A bill, 632A?

SENATOR LAMB: I move that LB 632A be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no, 632A. We are voting on the 632A, the advancement of the bill. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. 632A is advanced. We pass over 705 and go down to LB 651.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 651 was introduced by Senator Merz. (Read title.) The bill was read January 9, referred to Judiciary. There are committee amendments pending by the Judiciary Committee, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Is there a member of the Judiciary Committee? Committee amendments to 651.

CLERK: You are striking "shall" and inserting "may" on your committee amendments, Senator.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, the amendment which was offered by the committee provides for this to be permissive rather than mandatory and that is all that it accomplishes and I would move for its adoption.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendment as explained by Senator Stoney. All those in favor
