CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Public Works whose Chairman is Senator Kremer to whom was referred LB 643 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments; 829 General File with amendments; 946 General File with amendments; 830 indefinitely postponed; 931 indefinitely postponed; and 984 indefinitely postponed.
