LB 423, 361, 694, 877, 945

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion to advance the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Goodrich. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 361.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, right before that, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have carefully examined LB 945 and recommend same be placed on Select File with amendments; 877 Select File with amendments; 694 Select File with amendments. (Signed) Senator Wesely.

Mr. President, LB 361, title read. The bill was read on January 17 of last year. It was referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by Senator Carsten's Revenue Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, and members of the Legislature, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments. The committee amendments did change from two cents to one cent. However, there are some amendments to the committee amendments because of the lapse of one year that I think that we ought to address if that is proper at this time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I move for the adoption of the committee amendments. However the committee amendments did change the original bill from two cents increase to one but the application of the increase is a year late because of the tax on the gasohol program did raise last year one cent and so we need to amend those to make it current and I do have an amendment up there to the committee amendments that would do just that. Would it be proper to address that first?
