SENATOR LAMB: Yes, Mr. Chairman. I wonder if it would be in order to apprise the members that came in of what the issue is.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Why don't you explain what your amendment does.

SENATOR LAMB: This would leave the one-third, one-third, one-third share that we have had in the past instead of the one-sixth share that the budget committee by a five to four vote decided should be the new share.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, roll call. Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 19 ayes, 23 nays, 2 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting. Vote appears on page 1273 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have any other motions?

CLERK: Yes, I have one for Senator Lewis who is excused. Wants me to read it? Mr. President, Senator Lewis moves to amend the bill (read Lewis amendment). Now he wants to withdraw it and place it on on Select File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, so ordered. Are we ready to advance the bill?

CLERK: Yes, sir, we are.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, Senator Warner, do you wish to advance?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, Mr. President, I move LB 995 be advanced.
