SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record your presence, please. Will you record your presence please if you haven't already? You've got to record your presence.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have any items under #4?

CLERK: Just one very quickly, Mr. President. New bill, LB 691A. (Read by title for the first time as found on pages 1486-87 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Unless there are objections, while we are waiting for a few more to come in, we will take item #6 which is LR 211. The Clerk will read the resolution.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 211 was introduced by Senator Marsh. (Read LR 211.) Mr. President, that resolution is on page 1094-95 of the Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Good morning, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I am very pleased to be in a position to offer this resolution to the legislative body this morning. Tonight is the special occasion when Dr. Manley is among those being honored by Union College. He has made an important contribution to our community and to the college which he has led for the past several years. I urge you to unanimously adopt LR 211.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? All those in favor of the adoption of the resolution vote aye, opposed no. We are on item #6, LR 211. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the resolution.
