LB 999

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 999 there are E & R amendments that the body needs to consider.

SPEAKER MARVEL: To LB 999?

CLERK: Yes, sir, E & R amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely, do you want to move the E & R amendments to 999?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 999.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. E & R amendments to LB 999 are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the Appropriations Committee now offers an amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment. What this amendment does is two things, two parts. One has no change in dollar amounts but it corrects a computation error on the personal service limitation at the University Central Administration. It merely reflects that. The second amendment adds \$50,000 to the appropriation for the biomass research project that was contained in LB 965. It was enacted in 1978, and at the time that that appropriation was approved by the Legislature, it was the intent that it would be a four year program and it was not included in the part of the University's request. It was dropped out somewhere along the line or at least did not get included and since the Legislature or a previous Legislature had indicated that this was to be a four year program why the committee has voted to, and for the purpose that the program has, the committee voted to recommend to you that that additional funding be added as a second year funding for this program. So I move adoption of the committee amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes, do you want to speak to the.. ..okay, the motion, Senator Warner, is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 999, is that correct? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the adoption of the Appropriation Committee amendments to LB 999. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.
