PRESIDENT: Thirty seconds, Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: ...serious about relieving the call upon property tax to support public schools which is really a tax reform measure then Senator Vickers has the right idea. It may not trigger too much of an increase in our associated tax in the State of Nebraska. Possibly three percentage points in income tax might be the answer to meet this issue counting any surpluses that this body has over an overlevy. I do not think it is unreasonable and I support Senator Vickers and I admire his courage for trying to get at the issue.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, Mr. President, I would ask for a Call of the House and a roll call vote on this issue.

PRESIDENT: All right, that is a good point at this time. All those in favor of a Call of the House right at this point vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will bring in all the members. The Exec Board is meeting over here, if you can bring those members in for the vote. All members return to your desks and register your presence please. All nonlegislative personnel leave the floor. The House is under Call.

CLERK: Mr. President, while we are waiting Senator Haberman would like to print amendments to 986. (See page 1528 of the Legislative Journal.) Senator Haberman offers explanation of vote. Senator Labeledz moves to reconsider the body's action and adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment to LB 999. That will be laid over.

PRESIDENT: Has everyone registered his or her presence? Senator Koch, Senator Landis, Senator Keyes, Senator Kremer, Senator Haberman and Barrett, would you register your presence, please? All right, we are ready to have a roll call vote then on the Vickers amendment to LB 1002. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay, roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.
