LB 715A, 989A, 684A

SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all recorded your presence?

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator Wesely offers a new bill, LB 715A. (Read LB 715A).

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you ready to start now?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Item number six, General File, and the first one is LB 989A.

CLERK: Read LB 989A. The bill was first read on March 17th and referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of LB 989A. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting to advance five bills and then we go to the special order on revenue. Have you all voted? We are voting to advance the bill. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried the bill is advanced. The next bill is 684A.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 684A was introduced by Senator Warner. (Read the bill).

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, do you want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I have an amendment that just went up there. What the amendment does is changes the level to be consistent with what is in the appropriation bill, it actually reduces does it not, yes, there is some reduction from the original estimate but it makes the appropriation bill language consistent with the funding for LB 684, plus it has some necessary language amending the budget bill as to reflect the passage of the act should it pass. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is the adoption of the amendment to 684A. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.
