CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment is adopted. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. Chairman, I move that LB 765 be readvanced to E & R Final.

SENATOR CLARK: All those in favor of the motion say aye, all those opposed. The bill is advanced.
