LB 882, 882A

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, debate has ceased. Senator Labeledz, do you want to close on your motion?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Well, after this morning's vote and I am sure that we will probably get 20 votes....I mean 30 votes, I'm sorry, we need 30...we got 20 this morning, to suspend the rules and vote LB 882 to advance it to E & R Initial without any further debate. This morning you proved to me that by withdrawing all the amendments and by what we did this morning, by our actions this morning, that we don't want to continue, go hour after hour on a bill, and I am a good loser. When I know...and I support 691, and I will support it to the end, but 691 is dead. All we have got is 882. Let's move it. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 882 to E & R for Review. Is that right? Okay, I am sorry. The motion is to suspend the rules. So we are after 30 votes to start with and then we go from there. All those in favor of a suspension of the rules vote aye, opposed vote no. Shall the rules be suspended? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now we are ready to....the motion now is the advancement of 882 to E & R for Review. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of the bill. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 13 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is carried. The bill is advanced. What is the next motion?

CLERK: 882A.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 882A was introduced by Senator Schmit. (Read title to LB 882A.) I have an amendment pending by Senator George, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator George. Pat.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator George wishes to withdraw that amendment. So the motion is to advance the A bill.
