LR 197, 216

Mr. President, an appreciation note from Senator Keyes and I have a report from the Department of Health, Bureau of Examining Boards that will be on file in my office.

PRESIDENT: We are ready then to go to agenda item #5, resolutions, and we will start with LR 197.

CLERK: (Read LR 197.) Mr. President, that resolution is on page 604 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this resolution is one which I have drafted to get some recognition to a group which is rather new in the State of Nebraska, the physicians assistants. They have been doing an excellent job of assisting and providing the medical care to the Nebraska residents. I felt the group should be recognized and I ask for an affirmative vote on the resolution.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on LR 197? Senator Schmit, I guess that is it. No one wants to talk so that is your opening and I assume that is your close so the question is the adoption of LR 197. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and LR 197 is adopted. The next resolution is LR 216.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 216 offered by Senator Koch. It is found on page 1212. (Read LR 216.) Mr. President, that is Senator Koch's resolution and it is on page 1212.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President and members of the body, contrary to what we sometimes believe the school counsellors do provide an excellent service and since there is a week that has been set aside for that kind of an honorarium, I ask for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on LR 216? If not, Senator Koch, I guess that will be your opening and your closing so the question is the adoption of LR 216. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the resolution, Mr. President.
