CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate is ceased. Senator Kelly, do you want to close on your amendment?

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, I would like to close. There were two statements made in the outstanding debate that we have had on this amendment. Senator George states very plainly is that he is opposing this amendment based on the fact that he is very, very sure, personally convinced, that there will not be any bonds sold for this purpose. I agree with what Senator George's opinion on this amendment is. There will not be any bonds sold. That is my opinion, too, Senator George. Senator DeCamp opposes this amendment based on the very fact and the very necessity that in the immediate future and into the future the only source of money, the only source of money that would be available for this program would come from the Nebraska Mortgage Fund. Now that is a difference of opinion. One is that there will never be any bonds sold, the other one is that there is never going to be any money unless there are some bonds sold. With the wide divergence of that opinion and there is no unity of thought whatsoever regarding loading up unnecessarily the Nebraska Mortgage Fund with responsibilities that it cannot discharge and causing the consumer of this state to believe that there will be monies available through utility agents or through small loan companies or mortgage companies or banks. It just will not happen. Please accept the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Kelly amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, this is a crucial issue and I would ask for a Call of the House please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Shall the House go under Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators, please take your seats, record your presence, encourage unauthorized personnel to leave the floor. Have you all voted? Record your presence.
