SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record the vote,

CLERK: 30 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President, on the rules suspension.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to advance the bill to E & R for review without discussion. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye...all those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? As soon as we get through with this the Chair would suggest that we go to Select File and that Monday morning we would start on Final Reading and also there will be an attempt to override the Governor's veto. That will be Monday morning and there will be...if you have your worksheet handy the Final Reading bills will start with 485A and go through 819A. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labeledz, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR LABEDZ: (mike not turned on immediately) ...I would like to discuss something with the Chair.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, ma'am.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Last night we worked until about seven thirty and I don't think it created a hardship on anyone. We've got an awful lot of work to do and I'm not going to beat around the bush. I think that I would prefer, and I want your comments and those of others, whether or not we couldn't stay on General File until at least six o'clock and then go on to Select File inasmuch as we stayed here until seven thirty last night and the days are getting, only three left, whether or not we couldn't work tonight even if it is very late when we go on to Select File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, Senator Labeledz, the Chair only has to make a decision. I detect that the Legislature isn't too happy with the procedure. I fail to see that there is much difference between what we are doing now than what we did on a consent calendar but I said a while ago and I think I should stick with this and you have a privilege of overruling this, that we move from General File to Select File and I am prepared now to go to Select File, LB 628, but anybody in this room who is unhappy with this procedure, please sound off. That is all I have to say.
