CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1910 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 5 nays, 2 excused and not voting and six present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. Now before we recess, while the Legislature is in session...okay, go ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have carefully examined LB 817 and find the same correctly enrolled, 818, 818A, 819, 819A, 485, 485A, 834, 834A, 849, 849A, 709, 839, 839A, 867, 867A all correctly enrolled.

Your Enrolling Clerk reports that she has on this day at 10:58 a.m. presented to the Governor for his approval LB 615, 615A, 618, 618A, 701, 701A, 712, 712A, 731, 731A, 789 and 789A.

Mr. President, a new resolution, LR 344 by Senator Kremer. (Read as found on page 1911-12 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over, Mr. President. That is all I have, Senator.
