ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 1971 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 643 passes, and the Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 647.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 647 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 647 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.
