CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 1975 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 10 nays, 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 690A passes with the emergency clause attached. The next bill on Final Reading is LB 694, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 694 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 694 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.
