LR 337, 338, 339

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the resolution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried. The resolution is adopted. LR 338.

CLERK: LR 338 by Senators Wesely and Carsten on page 1728. Read.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this resolution was co-signed by all but one member of the body. It is in praise and commendation of the University of Nebraska-Lincoln gymnastics team. They did an outstanding job. If any of you had a chance to watch their performances at the Bob Devaney Sports Center you will know how excellent they are. I think they deserve this recognition and support and I would encourage your support for the resolution. Senator Carsten particularly co-signed the resolution.
