LEGISLATIVE BILL 463

AN ACT to amend sections 33-109 and 33-112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to fees; to change the fees for recording or indexing certain instruments; to eliminate a fee; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 33-109, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows: 33-109. The register of deeds and the county clerk shall receive for recording a deed, mortgage, or release, or any other instrument, a fee of three dollars per page, recording and indexing of a will, a fee of six dellars, recording and indexing of a decree in a testate estate, recording proof of publication, or recording any other instrument, a fee of five mime dollars per page, provided, that when the will or decree exceeds five pages, an additional fee of three dollars per page for each page more than five pages. The cost for a certified copy of any instrument filed or recorded in the office of county clerk or register of deeds shall be one dollar and fifty cents per page. The fee for adding a certificate and seal shall be fifty cents.

Sec. 2. That section 33-112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

33-112. For entering each instrument presented for record in the numerical index after the completion thereof, the clerk or register of deeds shall receive the sum of fifty twenty-five cents for each entry, to be paid in advance by the person offering the instrument for record. The flat fee provided by section 33-109, for recording of a decree entered in an intestate case, and for recording of a certified copy of the will, certificate of probate, and decree entered in a testate case, shall include the fee for all indexing under this section.

Sec. 3. That original sections 33-109 and 33-112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
