

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the advancement of the bill on 249. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting no.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? The House is technically under Call because we have never raised the Call. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote. Senator Parrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: I would like to ask for a Call of the House.

SENATOR CLARK: The House is under Call. We can have everyone check in.

SENATOR BARRETT: May we have everybody check in, please? Roll call.

SENATOR CLARK: Everyone will check in. Do you want a roll call vote? Senator Barrett, did you ask for a roll call vote?

SENATOR BARRETT: Yes.

SENATOR CLARK: All right. Will everyone check in, please. We have five excused. Senator Wiitala, Senator Lamb, Senator Schmit. Is he excused? Would everyone check in please. We have only three excused at the present time. Senator Warner is here. Would he check in, please. Would everyone take their seats, please. (Gavel.) Will everyone take their seats please or we will never get this out of the way. Senator Higgins, would you poke your button please. Senator Wiitala. Senator Haberman, Senator Hoagland, Senator Lamb, Senator Rod Johnson. We still have five that haven't checked in that are here. We are voting on the advancement of LB 249. Haberman, Hoagland, Rod Johnson and Wiitala. Would everyone stay in their seats please, we are going to have a roll call vote. Senator Barrett, do you want to go ahead with the roll call vote?

SENATOR BARRETT: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CLARK: If everyone will get in their seats please we will start the roll call vote. We are voting on the advancement of LB 249. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 377 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.
