Pappas, record your presence. Members are to be in their seats on the Call of the House. Senator Schmit and Senator Rod Johnson, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Rod Johnson. Senator Hefner, do you wish roll call or do you wish the Call to be raised?
