

increasing the in lieu tax to the schools, that is, as Senator Kilgarrin, that is a policy decision I can accept. I think it ought to be addressed on that basis and that I think now has been explained and is very clear policy issue that is being raised. I would suggest that you vote on that basis and get on with it, and I would urge also to forget...not having anything to do with this bill, but one of the real shortcomings of the one-house Legislature and the nonpartisan body when anyone questions anyone's bill, you immediately are attacked from all directions, and I would hope that if we are using this is an example, because there has been two or three bills that have gone across that I had an urge to get up and challenge the other day and didn't. I have had one or two that I think someone ought to urge...have the urge to challenge. I would hope that we would understand that we can discuss these on a policy issue basis and on that issue alone, just as we did, Senator DeCamp, there was attempts on a bill the other day that you had an interest in....

PRESIDENT: One minute, Senator.

SENATOR WARNER:to suggest all kinds of other things. So I would hope that we could avoid that kind of a situation and address this issue on the same basis as it was presented. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question is on the adoption of the Kilgarrin amendment. I am going to ask for a machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote. Record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 425 and 426 of the Legislative Journal.) 6 ayes, 33 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion failed. Back to the bill. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: I move the bill be advanced, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance the bill from Select File to Enrollment and Review for Engrossment. Machine vote is requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.
