SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Those of you in your office listening, please return to the floor so we can get rolling. Please record your presence. Let's record our presence, please. Soon as we get assembled, we're going to go back to Final Reading and finish up here so we can get going. So those listening in, please return to the floor if you wish to vote on these Final Reading bills; they're short. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: There's a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Do you have anything to put in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, bills read on Final Reading this morning will, have been presented to the Governor as of 1:15. I have an Attorney General's opinion to Senator Hoagland. (See pages 2391-92 in the Journal). And Mr. President, LR's 200, 201, 202 are ready for your signature.

SPEAKER NICHOL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign Legislative Resolution 200, 201, and 202. If you'll please return to your seats, we'll read 411. Please return to your seats and we'll go on LB 411. You gentlemen in the middle aisle, will you please return to your seats so we can, thank you. Proceed, Mr. Clerk, on the Final Reading, LB 411 with the emergency clause attached.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 411 on Final Reading.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor, vote aye, opposed, nay. Have you all voted? Please vote, if you wish to. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Vote given. (See page 2393-94 in the Journal). Vote is 34 ayes, 6 nays, 6 excused not voting, 3 present not voting, Mr. President. (See Journal 34 ayes, 6 nays, 3 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting).

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 411 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 604 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Kahle would move to return 604 to Select File for specific amendment. The amendment is on page 2292.
