LB 635, 636

CLERK: 635 by the Exec Board, offered by Senator Johnson as Chair. (Read title.)

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, apparently when we passed LB 404 in 1982 establishing the Department of Aging we made a reference to the older statute regarding the Nebraska Commission on Aging at which place the head of the Nebraska Commission on Aging is designated as the Executive Director, as the Executive Director. Now in truth and fact the person who holds the position of the head of the Department of Aging is known as the Director of the Department of Aging. All this bill does is to make certain that the person who is the head of the Department of Aging is the Director. That should have been caught in the passage of LB 404 but was not. I move the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the discussion on LB 635. Is that the one we are on? 635. All those in favor of advancing the bill please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 635 is advanced. LB 636.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, LB 636 is repealing a section of the law that authorized people who obtained a driver's license between September 2, 1977 and January 3, 1978 to obtain the license with a photograph at no charge. Inasmuch as more than four years has passed since that very discreet time period and all licenses issued at that time would have been renewed at least once since then, this particular provision is genuinely obsolete and should simply be repealed. I move advancement of 636.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the discussion. All those in favor of advancing LB 636 please vote aye, opposed nay. Could you help me out a little bit, please. We are voting on the advancement of LB 636. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 636.
