

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Will you please return to your seats. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor, record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Thank you. Four are excused. Please record your presence, otherwise I will name names. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I will take call ins, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, we are voting on the advancement of the bill. Call ins have been authorized. Please record your presence.

CLERK: Senator Morehead voting yes. Senator Chronister voting yes. Senator Hefner voting yes. Senator Lamb voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 252 advances. LB...do you have anything to read in, Mr. Clerk, at this time?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, very quickly. Just one item. Your committee on Ag and Environment whose Chair is Senator Johnson gives notice of public hearing for Friday, March 1.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 313 offered by Senator Wesely. (Read title.) The bill was first read on January 17 of this year. It was referred to the Public Health and Welfare Committee for hearing. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.
