CLERK: Senator Sieck voting no. Senator Remmers voting no. Senator Chizek voting yes. Senator Scofield voting yes. Senator Vickers voting yes. Senator Abboud voting yes.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Chambers voting yes.

PRESIDENT: The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 213.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. The bill is advanced. The call of the house is raised. We will move now to Select File because we are behind time on the Speaker's agenda. LB 116.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 116.

PRESIDENT: Senator Landis, we are moving to Select File for LB 116.

CLERK: The E & R amendments were adopted by the Legislature on February 22. We discussed it on February 22, Mr. President. Senator Lamb and others had a motion to bracket the bill until May 1, 1985. That is pending.

PRESIDENT: Motion to bracket the bill to May 1 is pending. That is the issue before the house. Senator Lamb, do you wish to speak again on that motion? I was not here, Senator, not knowing whether you did speak or not on the motion to bracket the bill until May 1. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, we had the end of discussion, as I recall. Senator Lamb was recognized for closing and made a motion to adjourn. I believe he's been recognized for his closing.

PRESIDENT: Well, then you may proceed, Senator Lamb, to...
