LB 47, 89, 315

PRESIDENT: Thank you. You heard the motion to advance LB 89. All those in favor vote aye...say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 315.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment I have is by Senator Beutler.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler. Do we know what the amendment is?

CLERK: Senator, should I reference amendment number for you, so we're...track?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Would you please, Pat.

CLERK: It's amendment #286, 286. (See page 874 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: (Gavel.) Senator Beutler.
