CLERK: Mr. President, 29 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of LR 74.

PRESIDENT: LR 74 is adopted. Next is LR 75.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp has offered a resolution regarding the Clearwater Class D-1 Boys Basketball Champions honoring Coach Rick Hesse and his team.

PRESIDENT: Coach DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Yeah, Clearwater.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to suspend the rules to take up the...we are in a position to consider LR 75 then. Senator DeCamp has moved that it be adopted. Is there further discussion? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 75.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted. Senator Johnson, do you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes, Mr. President, I have a point of order for the Speaker, for Speaker Nichol, so I need to ask Speaker Nichol this question before we begin on the consent calendar. The question I really have of Speaker Nichol is this, we are going to take time this morning, Mr. Speaker, to deal with a variety of consent bills and in doing so we are foreclosing debate on our property tax relief measures, LB 38, which was moving along day before yesterday and we were getting ready for it yesterday, will that be taken up at the beginning of next week?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Johnson, yes, however, I had scheduled 662 for discussion Monday so that bill and Senator Lamb's bill will be taken up Tuesday.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: But we'll take 662 up then Monday then. Is that right?
