

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Let's run through the lights, then we'll have a call of the house. Senator Goll, you ready to go? Okay. Senator Lundy. Yes. Senator Labedz. Yes. Senator Harris. SENATOR CARSTEN: You didn't read that, though, that was not before us.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, Senator Carsten, it's a good point. The motion to suspend the rules has been withdrawn. Right? Okay. Right, Senator? Yes, okay. Now the motion before us is to advance the bill by Senator Morehead. Right?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Yes.

SENATOR CARSTEN: I didn't hear her make it, and I don't think it was read, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Senator Morehead, did you make that motion, or didn't you? Maybe I misunderstood.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: I thought I had acknowledged that, but I would like to make the motion to advance 496. I thought I'd done that, but I'm not sure.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. I could have misunderstood. If you didn't do it, that was in my mind.
