SPEAKER NICHOL: No further lights. Would you like to close, Senator Withem, now?

SENATOR WITHEM: I would ask for the advancement of this bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance LB 532, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. May I introduce a few guests. Under the south balcony we have a famous former senator here, Senator Ramey Whitney who is now in Senator Haberman's district. Would you please welcome him back to the Legislature. Thank you, Senator Whitney. We also have guests of Senator Lamb, Mr. Al Cooper of Broken Bow and Terry Ziegler with the Custer Public Power District. They are under the north balcony. Would you please rise. And Senator Harry Chronister has guests in the south balcony. There are 8 eighth grade students from St. Wenceslaus in Dodge, Nebraska, and their teacher. Would you please rise. Thank you. Senator Hoagland, have you decided whether you wish to proceed with 32CA?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Yes, it's my understanding we do, Mr. Speaker. What kind of amendments...are there any amendments on the bill? There is committee amendments, I suspect, which Senator Rupp I imagine would handle.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 32 was offered by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. It's a resolution to propose an amendment to Article VII, Section 10. It was referred to the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee for public hearing. it was advanced to General File. There are Constitutional Committee amendments pending, Mr. President.
