PRESIDENT: (Microphone not activated.)...the Interim Pastor of the First Baptist Church in Lincoln, Nebraska. I'm glad to present Dr. William Hayler.

DR. HAYLER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you very much, Dr. Hayler, for coming to us this morning. Members will please record your presence for roll call. (Gavel.) Attention members of the Legislature throughout the Capitol Building. A roll call is underway in the Legislative Chamber. Please come to the Legislative Chamber to record your presence so that we may acquire a quorum to begin the 69th Legislative Day. A quorum call is underway. Members please record your presence. Roll call is underway. Members of the Legislature, Final Reading is the first item on business today. If you would please come to the Chamber, so that we can acquire a sizable quorum to begin the 69th Legislative Day, we would appreciate it. Record the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum is present. (Gavel.) The Legislature is in session. Do you have corrections to the Journal?
