LB 518

CLERK: I appreciate that, Governor. I have one item. Mr. President, on LB 518, I have E & R amendments to LB 518, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to adopt the amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment to the bill from Senator Beutler. The amendment is on page 2275.

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, this is a procedures bill, it has to do with special education procedures. Since our last go around on debate, it was noncontroversial then I hope it is still noncontroversial, but we changed a few of those procedures to bring it in line with a recent Supreme Court case and you can see those procedures set out in the amendment. I would be glad to answer questions about the change in procedures but I think they are simply fairly technical. It was worked out by both proponents of...by a lawyer representing parents of special education children, or children who benefit from special education and by the school districts, and to the best of my knowledge I think they are noncontroversial at this point. I would ask adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the Beutler amendment? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. You are voting on the Beutler amendment just offered to LB 518. Please record your vote. May we have your attention to the voting on the Beutler amendment to LB 518 and record your vote please. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment to LB 518, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
