SENATOR SMITH: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the advancement of the bill. We have had a request for a record vote so if you care to vote, please do so. Have you all voted that care to? A record vote has been asked for. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1664 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1001 advances. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 380. We move on to the A bill with this 1001. Senator Peterson, we have an A bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1001A. (Read title.) It was introduced by Senator Peterson. Introduced on March 3, referred directly to General File.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, do you wish to speak to that, that A bill?

SENATOR WARNER: No, I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, is there any further...Senator Hall, did you wish to discuss the A bill?

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I just have a question for either Senator Warner or Senator Peterson. What is the amount of General Funds we are talking about?
