PRESIDENT MCGINLEY PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: Stand for the prayer this morning. In the absence of a Chaplain, we have a volunteer from our own group, the Reverend James Goll. Senator Goll.

SENATOR GOLL: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Goll. Members, please record your presence for roll call.

(Recorder malfunctioned. Legislative Journal shows the following read by the Clerk: Corrections for the Journal, message from the Governor regarding LB 131 and LB 131A; new resolutions, LR 385, LR 386, LR 387, and LR 388. See pages 1750-55.)

PRESIDENT: ...from the Appropriations Committee.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner as Chair of the Appropriations Committee would move for the introduction of a new bill by the committee, Request 1918.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, the motion is to suspend the rule to allow the introduction of the bill, the appropriation bill that carries the funds necessary for the civil action claims, the dollar amount. In total it's perhaps 7 or 8 cases and the amount is in total about \$35,000, and the various Standing Committees that under statute are required to review those have all reviewed and approved them as has the Appropriations Committee, but it needs to have a separate bill. So I would ask for the suspension of the rules so that the bill could be introduced and placed on General File.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on Senator Warner's motion? If not, the motion is...excuse me, Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Warner, would you yield to a question, please?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Yes, this bill, I want to ask some questions about the bill. Do you want them asked now or after it is
