LB 1160, 1227

CLERK: Bear with me, Senator. LB 1227, Senator, does have E & R pending.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on that bill, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 1227 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossing.

SPEAKER NICHOL: A machine vote has been requested. And the question is, shall LB 1227 advance? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I'll ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Those outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Hefner, record your presence. Senator McFarland, Senator Sieck, Senator Hannibal, Senator Chambers, Senator Chronister, Senator Warner, Senator Lamb, Senator Hefner. We're looking for Senator Schmit, Senator Warner. Roll call vote has been requested. We are voting on the advancement of LB 1227.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1990 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1227 fails to advance. LB 1160. The call is raised.

CLERK: Senator, 1160, I do have E & R amendments pending.
