SENATOR REMMERS: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments be approved.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. They are approved.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have an amendment to the bill from Senator Rod Johnson.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Sieck.

SENATOR SIECK: The amendment is number 2886. The purpose of that amendment is to compromise with the USDA as far as our milk laws are concerned. That is what it does.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Excuse me. The last part was not on. Would you say that again, please.

SENATOR SIECK: Yes. We need to get the two bills together, 898 to 900. They cover about the same thing.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. You've heard the motion...all those... Is there any further discussion? Senator Haberman. Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Mr. President, what was the amendment?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Sieck, will you state that again.

SENATOR SIECK: The amendment is to make the milk laws come up to USDA standards that we have here in Nebraska.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Was that LB 898, originally?

SENATOR SIECK: Right.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Senator Sieck.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Sieck amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment offered by Senator Sieck on behalf of Rod Johnson.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted.
