

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Chronister's amendment to the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Chronister amendment is adopted. Do you have another amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to amend his bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. I will be brief again on this. Mr. Speaker, members, we did have a situation in the Health Committee where there is a person who was selected to serve on a board who isn't even a resident of Nebraska. We found that we approved that appointment but it really bothered some of us in the Health Committee that we would have somebody serving on a Nebraska licensing agency that didn't even live in Nebraska, and so this amendment would require that those people that serve on health boards and commissions would have to be residents of the State of Nebraska. It seems logical. It falls in line with Senator Haberman's bill that he had a few years ago that when Nebraska licensing boards hold their meetings they have to hold them in the state. So I would ask your support for this amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Wesely amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. (Gavel.) Ladies and gentlemen, let's move. We need to roll along. Record, please, and thank you.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. One more.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lamb would move to amend the bill. (Lamb amendment appears on page 2031 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Lamb.
